1. Pulpit Ministry

This track is for participants who feel called to a preaching ministry.

A. Includes those desiring to become:

- Pastors
- Evangelists
- Missionaries
- Lay Ministers

B. Expectations:

- Will be set forth as lay ministers
- Will complete the Foundations Course
- Will eventually meet with the Ministerial Review Board

2. Localized Ministry

This track is for participants who are called to serve in various ministries/departments in the local church.

A. Includes those desiring to serve in the areas of:

- Children's Ministry
- Media/Sound
- Men's Ministry
- Promotional/Marketing/Web Design
- Women's Ministry
- Worship Leading
- Youth Ministry
- Additional Helps Ministry

B. Expectations:

- Will be accountable to the local pastor & serve as needed
- Will commit to regular Bible Study & prayer time
- Will commit to working diligently with other leaders in the local church

3. Serving Ministry

This track is for participants who are called to service to the local church, particularly as a help to the pastor and ministry leaders.

A. Includes those desiring to become:

- Clerks
- Deacons/Deaconesses
- Treasurers

B. Expectations:

- Will offer their services freely to the local church/pastor
- Will actively work to obtain skills necessary to meet the needs of the local church

4. Personal Development

This track is for participants who do not feel a pull to a particular ministry, but wish to grow in spiritual maturity.
